

A ALL ARE SINNERS. Romans 3:10-18, 21-32.

- ❖ We are sinners and we can't choose to do good.
- ❖ The Holy Spirit is the only one that generates...
 - conviction that we are sinners.
 - elimination of pride.
 - desire of approaching Jesus to obtain forgiveness.
 - a change in our lives.

B NON-BELIEVERS. Romans 1:22-27.

- ❖ Paul's words reflect everything we read in the newspapers and watch on the news.
 - Images of saints, animal talismans.
 - Deifying the ego, sports, movies and fashion stars...
 - Widespread homosexuality.
 - AIDS and Sexually Transmitted Diseases.
- ❖ Since sin appeared in our world, man has become corrupted and has fled from God. The only solution for every man is accepting Jesus as his personal Savior.

C BELIEVERS. Romans 2:1-3, 17-24.

- ❖ Believers boast of not being like the "pagans" and judge them. Nevertheless, believers are sinning like non-believers.
- ❖ God judges the believers, too. He demands more from them, because they have more knowledge of the truth than non-believers.
- ❖ The only solution for the believers is to surrender to God every moment of your life.
- ❖ Believers and non-believers, men and women, rich and poor... we all are sinners and are condemned.
- ❖ There wouldn't be hope for anyone if it wasn't for God's grace.

D GOD'S SOLUTION FOR THE SINNER. Romans 1:16-17.

- ❖ The justice of God means that anyone who has faith in the Gospel (Jesus' death at the cross) will obtain salvation.
- ❖ When you believe in Jesus' death by faith, it is that faith that leads you to trust God more and more. We have life and we are called righteous through that faith.

E REPENTANCE. Romans 2:5-10.

- ❖ A sinner can't cling to the salvation God provided (Jesus' death) by faith. That faith leads to repentance and to a change in his life.
- ❖ Repentant sinners persevere in doing good.
- ❖ Unrepentant sinners do evil.
