

A How does grace abound MUCH MORE when sin abounds? Romans 5:20.

- ❖ Grace is enough to forgive **every** sin.
- ❖ Grace solves the terrible results of sin.
- ❖ Grace defeats death and gives us eternal life through Jesus.
- ❖ Grace can transform us.

B According to Romans 6:1-11, Christians die to sin through baptism.

How is that possible?

- ❖ Through baptism...
 - The old self dies (our sinful desires) and we are free from sin
 - The new self is raised from the dead (we no longer serve the sin)
 - We live for God

C If a believer dies to sin through baptism, could he sin again? Romans 6:12.

- ❖ Yes, he could, but he is able to choose whether he wants to be ruled by sin or not.
- ❖ The old man **DESIRE**s to live for sin.
- ❖ The new man **DESIRE**s to live for God, although he might sin sometimes.
- ❖ We cannot overcome sin by ourselves. Only by faith and thanks to God's promises we can overcome sin.

D What does 'not to be under law, but under grace' involves?

- ❖ To be 'under the law' means to use the law as a way to salvation.
- ❖ To be 'under grace' means to use grace as a way to salvation.

E If we are no more under the law, why must we keep it? Romans 6:15.

- ❖ Man is free from sin's control only by God's grace. Therefore, how could he be right or reasonable to stand deliberately under the old slavery?
- ❖ Anyone who refuses to be led to obedience to God's law by His grace is rejecting that grace; he is rejecting God's freedom and salvation.

F Are you a slave to sin or to obedience? Romans 6:16.

- ❖ Slaves to sin = Death.
- ❖ Slaves to obedience = Righteousness.

G How can we become slaves to obedience? Romans 6:18.

- ❖ The right doctrine or teaching helps us to become "slaves to righteousness."

H What do we obtain when we are freed from sin? Romans 6:19-23.

- ❖ We are made slaves to God.
- ❖ We have our fruit to holiness.
- ❖ We have eternal life in Jesus Christ, our Lord.
