Adam lost immortality:

POSSIBILITIES OF THE SOUL AT THE DEATH OF THE BODY

- Going to Heaven: Hope that comforts the believer.
- Going to Hell: Eternal Suffering of the Sinner.
- Go to "limbo": Disembodied spirits wandering aimlessly and communicating with the living.
- Reincarnation: New life with no conscious memory of the previous one.

IF WE GO TO HEAVEN

- Would we be happy to see the sufferings and mistakes of our beloved family and friends?
- Wouldn't we try to help them to save themselves?

IF HELL EXISTS

- God and the saints are sadists who enjoy the eternal suffering of sinners.
- Eternal punishment is disproportionate to the faults that can be committed in a short life

IF WE BECOME DISEMBODIED SPIRITS

- If we all have the same destiny, what does it matter what we do in this life?
- Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we shall die.

Almost all Christian churches have taught one of the following errors (with some variations):

- 1) There is a hell where sinners suffer eternally.
- 2) God is so good that He saves all men.

 Therefore, man ascends directly to heaven at death.

Today, Christian churches tend to favor the second error, including the Catholic Church.

When will the wicked receive their punishment?


All will be resurrected, both righteous and unjust

What does the Bible say about death?

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No one praises God when he has died

"For Sheol will not exalt you, nor death praise you; nor shall they that go down to the grave wait for thy truth." Isaiah, 38:18

THE CASE OF MIGOLIO

"Men and brethren, you may freely be told of the patriarch David, who died and was buried... For David did not ascend into heaven." Acts 2:29, 34

The doctrine of the immortality of the soul nullifies the resurrection

"I frankly confess that I am not convinced that they already enjoy the fullness of glory in which God and the elect angels find themselves. Nor is it an article of my faith; for if it were so, then I cannot but see that the preaching of the resurrection of the flesh would be in vain."

William Tyndale, in the foreword to his translation of the New Testament

The doctrine of the immortality of the soul nullifies the 2nd coming of Christ

Those who believe in immortality claim:

"For all practical purposes of comfort, the doctrine of the blessed immortality of the righteous supersedes for us any doubtful doctrine of the Lord's second coming. When we die is when the Lord comes to get us. That is what we have to wait for and for which we must be cautious. The dead have already entered into glory. They do not wait for the sound of the trumpet to stand in judgment and enter into beatitude."

The Bible states:

"For the Lord himself shall come down from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trumpet of God; and the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will be with the Lord always. Therefore encourage one another with these words."

1 Thessalonians, 4:16-18

Men Are Not Judged When They Die

"For He hath appointed a day in which He shall judge the world in righteousness" Acts 17:31

"And to the angels who did not keep their dignity... he has saved them... for the judgment of the great day" Jude, 6

"And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before God; and the books were opened, and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged by the things that were written in the books, according to their works." Revelation, 20:12

History of the Doctrine of Immortality in Christianity

- Rome took this doctrine from paganism.
- Luther classed it alongside "the monstrous fables that are part of the Roman dunghill"
- However, both Catholicism and Protestantism today embrace this doctrine.
